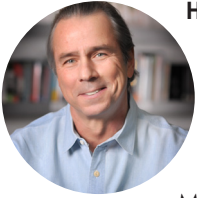

Howard A. Tullman is the CEO of 1871 — where digital startups get their start — and the General Managing Partner of G2T3V, LLC and of Chicago High Tech Investment Partners. He is a member of Mayor Emanuel's Chicago NEXT and Cultural Affairs Councils; the Innovate Illinois Advisory Council; the Illinois Arts Council; a member of President Preckwinkle's New Media Council; an adjunct professor at Kellogg; and an advisor to many start-ups. He is the former Chairman and CEO of Tribeca Flashpoint Media Arts Academy. Over the last 45 years, he has successfully founded more than a dozen high-tech companies. @tullman

Dr. Shawn Jackson, is the Deputy Chief of Teaching & Learning at Chicago Public Schools, where he is charged with developing a personalized learning framework that supports meaningful technology integration for all students across the District. He is spearheading the CPS initiative P.L.A.Y. (Personalized Learning Advancing Youth), which supports teachers and students in their implementation of a personalized teaching and learning model. In January 2015, the first component of P.L.A.Y. was introduced, CPS Connects. CPS Connects provides students connected learning environments by linking their school, home and community experiences. Prior to this role, Dr. Jackson was the principal of Spencer Technology Academy on the west side of Chicago. During his tenure, Spencer received national recognition for technology integration across curriculums.

Jennie Magiera, is the Digital Learning Coordinator for the Academy for Urban School Leadership, a network of 32 Chicago Public Schools, and previously taught math to 4th and 5th graders.
